FORMER ANGLICAN CLERGYMAN TO BE ORDAINED CATHOLIC PRIEST IN MILWAUKEE

On Saturday, March 19, Deacon Russell Arnett, a former Episcopal priest, will be ordained a Catholic priest for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Deacon Arnett, parish director for St. John the Baptist Parish, Union Grove, and St. Francis Xavier Parish, Kansasville, converted to Catholicism in 2007. Although he is married, he is able to be ordained to the priesthood under Pope John Paul II's 1980 Pastoral Provision, which allows for married Episcopal priests to be ordained if they have come into full communion with the Catholic Church.
