WEEKLY REFLECTIONS

Epiphany marks the end of the Christmas season. (It officially falls on January 6.) Consider establishing a new tradition based on the three gifts of the Magi and what gifts you will give in this coming year. For Gold (symbol of wealth), decide what will you give in charitable donations this year. For Frankincense (incense prayer offering), write down your own prayer for the coming year and as part of a little prayer service, burn the paper. For Myrrh (used to heal wounds as well as an embalming material) what wound in your heart needs healing – is there someone you need to forgive? Resolve to heal this and decide how you will do it.
