## In the Pope's Estimation

Pope Benedict reflected on his recent journey to the United Kingdom, that is, to England and Scotland. He did not get to Wales and Northern Ireland. He said "in the four intense and very beautiful days spent in that noble land, I had the great joy of speaking to the heart of the inhabitants of the United Kingdom, and they spoke to mine, especially with their presence and the testimony of their faith." He said he was "able to see how the Christian heritage is still strong and also active in all strata of social life." He made it clear that any apostolic journey was "to support the Catholic community, encouraging it to work tirelessly to defend the immutable moral truths that, taken up again, illumined and confirmed by the Gospel, are at the base of a truly human, just and free society." Pope Benedict is convinced that the old nations of Europe have a Christian soul, and the Church will not cease its efforts to maintain this spiritual and cultural tradition. We might add that the same Christian soul lies at the base of our founding as a nation not only from the colonists of New England but from the *conquistadores* and missionaries from Spain and Mexico and the *voyageurs* and missionaries from Quebec and France.
