2011 Racine Catholic Food Pantry statistics:

# of referrals - 2612      # of persons served - 8606

Throughout December and continuing this month, the pantry food supply is minimal. For one thing, the government is no longer sending peanut butter, probably because of a poor peanut crop, but food and cash donations have diminished considerably, as well.

- If your budget permits, we can especially use these items: hand soap, dish soap, pancake mix, syrup, peanut butter, cereal, saltines, toilet paper, canned meats, canned pasta and prepared dinner mixes.
- Donations can be dropped off in the ushers room on any weekend.

We're also "suffering" in our supply of volunteers, we need 4 people who can lift a bag of groceries.

- The job consists of a non-lifetime 2 hrs (9 a.m. - noon, or noon to 2 p.m.) a month with no homework or meetings, with a pretty viable substitute list, and I can help!
