**SAFE-ENVIRONMENT EDUCATION**

For any parishioners or parents who have regular contact with our school children... either as a room parent, a chaperone, a coach, a tutor, a catechist, a regular visitor, or the like, one needs to have received safe-environment certification. In order to be certified, one needs to authorize the parish and school to perform a criminal background check, to read and sign the Archdiocesan "Code of Ethical Standards", and to attend a three-hour safe-environment education (SEE) session. Our parish will host one of these SEE sessions next Wednesday, October 12th from 6:30-9:30 p.m. in Haban Hall. In order to attend and receive credit, one needs to register online. **Abridged MINUTES  
Sacred Heart Parish Council Meeting  
August 30, 2011**

**First Meeting of new council:** Larry called the meeting to order and welcomed new council members McCray, Schumacher, Winkler, Noelke.

**Minutes** of the June 28th meeting were approved and forwarded for abridgment for publication in the weekly bulletin.

**Trustees' Report:** Mary Ann reported that the fiscal year closed at the end of June and that details will be presented at the annual parish meeting in October. Don noted that approximately \$5,000 was received from the August parish celebration.

**Committee Reports:**

- Michelle distributed committee assignments, A draft of the 2011-2012 Council calendar was examined.
- Veronica distributed a brochure for Human Concerns and a summary of the History/Formation of HALO; the next blood drive will be on October 17.
- Michelle stressed the importance of communication with committees and suggested that the council invite a different committee chairperson to each meeting.
- Richard reported the following attendance numbers for 2011 Parish Celebration: Friday fish dinner--165, Saturday rib dinner--180, Sunday potluck--75. Richard, reporting on the school choice program for JPII Academy, said that 90 student-applications have been received and that 30 will be accepted; over 200 enrolled students are expected in the building this school year.
- \$15,000 has been collected for the now-completed water main project.

**Old Business:**

- Don said that reimbursement-amounts to be granted to JPII Academy under the school choice program must be determined by cost-per-student calculations which include materials, building costs, etc.; Al Pfeiffer is working on this.
- The council awaits direction from the archdiocese on precise wording of the concealed-carry signage to be posted announcing that no concealed weapons are allowed within or on school/parish facilities or property.
- Approximately \$150 will be requested from Administrative Services for each hospitality weekend event hosted by parish committees.

**New Business:**

- Larry distributed the Strategic Plan document from the Parish Council handbook; he initiated discussion of Parish Council Goals for the year and requested that each member identify two strategies (and possible implementation) from the "Vibrant Parish" grid in the handout which we might focus on.
- The Council will discuss welcoming activities for new parishioners at the next meeting; Chris Zurawski will place a copy of the new-parishioner packet in each member's mailbox for examination.
- The 2011-2012 Parish Council calendar was distributed; members should check dates assigned for new-parishioner registration and notify Larry or Paul N. by September 13 of any date switches that have been effected.

**Adjournment:** Richard led the closing prayer. Meeting adjourned at 9:10.
