Sacred Heart Parish Council Meeting

Minutes of May 31, 2011 at 7 p.m.

[Abridged minutes]

Trustees Report:

- **Don Trottier** reported contributions were up \$2500. The auction raised between \$40,000 to \$42,000, pending the final audit. The campaign for funds for the Water Main repair has brought in \$4,800 toward our \$55,000 goal. It was also suggested that a condensed version of the minutes of the Parish Council meetings be included in the weekly bulletin.

Committee Reports:

- The bulletin has been printing the amount received weekly for the water main break. It will continue until the goal is met.
- **Sarah Tringali** presented information on Pierre Antoine becoming a half time principal at John Paul II and half time at the newly formed Our Lady of Grace. The formation of the new school is set to receive 150 students in August. There will be some staff changes at both schools for the 2011-2012 school years.

Old Business:

- **Haban Hall** will be dedicated on June 18th beginning with Holy Mass at 4:30 by the Archbishop. Invitations have been mailed to Parish Members
- **SHARE** – "A Community Service" was updated for the council. It was suggested that flyers about the program be placed in the back of church and an item placed in the church bulletin. Requests for additional helpers could also be requested in the bulletin.
- **The Strategic Plan Report** was differed to the June meeting.
- **Veronica Cabiro and Terry Smith** updated the council on Discernment 2011. The incoming members will attend the June meeting, red binders will be passed onto the new members and evaluations, suggestions and comments will be reviewed.
- The search for chairperson/persons for **The Stewardship Committee** continues. Council members were recruited to make parish calls to sections of the family roster.
- **Grant request** information will be studied over the summer break.

Old Business:

- **Constitution review and bylaws** will take place over the summer and placed on the agenda for the next council.
- The next meeting of the Parish Council is **Tuesday June 28th at 7:00 p.m.**
