Sacred Heart Parish Council Meeting

Minutes of April 26, 2011 at 7 p.m.

[Abridged minutes]

Trustees Report:

- **Mary Ann Konsin** reported that we cannot have another fund drive for 14 months, until our latest campaign is completed due to archdiocese directives. We need to find ways to raise money for the water main repairs –approximately \$50,000 dollars. The Parish Council approved the budget submitted by the Administration Committee.

Committee Reports:

- **Larry Wilson** attended the Festival/Ad Hoc meeting and reported that the new name will be "The Parish Celebration Committee". The event will take place this year August 12th-14th. The committee is actively working on the events. Doug and Bernie Hoff are chairpersons.
- **Veronica Cabiro** reported that Human Concerns was interested in seeing "money figures" printed in the weekly bulletin. The Rose Sale for Mother's Day is ready with volunteer help.
- **Mary Hartl** advised the council of an ongoing program called "S.H.A.R.E.". She will present further information at next Parish Council Meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

- **Haban Hall:** The usage policy was discussed. Each request form will be considered on an individual basis. The policy was approved.
- **Vision Committee:** Follow-up, with Discussion and Action Items Status/Deadlines were updated, reviewed and handed out to Parish Council members.
- **Discernment 2011:** Went well. The new members and the exiting members will be acknowledged in the Parish Bulletin. Michelle will coordinate the Diocesan training for all council members.
- **Stewardship Committee:** It is still non-existent. The council will be given lists of parish members and a script to call as many as possible. This need is immediate and critical and must be filled.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Parish Council Training may be done online and at the Diocesan offices in St. Frances.
- Hospitality Weekend Schedules have been discussed.
- The 2011 agenda committee will be named in June with the new alternate to replace Judy Chiappetta.
